

## **Pre-budget consultations 2017-18: MOFED calls on Stakeholders to submit their proposals**

In the context of the pre-budget consultations, the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development issued a communiqué on Wednesday, February 22, inviting Business and Trade Associations, Professional Bodies, Trade Unions, NGOs, Civil Society Organisation and all stakeholders as well as the public at large to submit suggestions and proposals.

The press release states that the priorities of the Government for the next Budget exercise are employment creation, poverty alleviation, boosting private investment, modernisation of infrastructure, achieving a higher level of human development and improving the quality of life for all.

“ Our vision for the future of Mauritius is for a country of growth, in which every child, citizen and place matters”, specifies the communiqué.
