Execution of the 2025-2026 Performance-Based Budget

The purpose of this Circular Letter is to set out guidelines and instructions for Ministries, Departments and other public bodies for the smooth and effective execution of the 2025-2026 Performance-Based Budget (PBB).

- 2. The 2025-2026 PBB is based on three interconnected pillars Economic Renewal, A New Social Order and Fiscal Consolidation that collectively aim at addressing structural challenges, stimulating investment, enhancing productivity and economic growth, protecting the most vulnerable, and restoring fiscal discipline.
- 3. You are, therefore, required to strictly adhere to the guidelines and instructions outlined in this Circular to ensure the successful achievement of the goals and outcomes articulated by Government in the Budget Speech, Annex to Budget Speech and the PBB Estimates document.

Implementation of Budget Measures

- 4. The implementation of the budget measures is crucial for achieving the set economic growth and social progress targets.
- 5. Supervising Officers are, therefore, required to take all necessary actions to ensure the effective implementation of the measures. In this regard, for each measure under your responsibility, you must:
 - (a) define clear milestones, deliverables and timelines;
 - (b) upload these details on the Electronic Project Monitoring Information System (e-PMIS); and
 - (c) provide an update on the e-PMIS system on a monthly basis, i.e., within 10 days following the end of each reference month, on the status of implementation, including any delays and/or bottlenecks, and the actions taken to address them.

Strategies and Key Performance Indicators

- 6. The PBB framework has been re-introduced as from this financial year. Ministries and Departments have identified major challenges being faced and the strategies to address them. In addition, key performance indicators (KPI) and targets have been set with respect to the main services being provided.
- 7. You must, therefore, ensure the prompt and effective implementation of these strategies to enhance the quality of service delivery and meet the specified KPI targets.
- 8. For monitoring of progress, information on the KPIs and the targets pertaining to your respective Ministry or Department will be uploaded on the e-PMIS centrally by this Ministry. You are requested to provide updates on the status of the KPIs on the e-PMIS on a quarterly basis, within 10 days following the end of each reference quarter.
- 9. You are advised to establish additional KPIs at the level of your Ministry and Department that will help you reinforce the monitoring and improvement of service delivery performance.
- 10. You are also requested to submit information on the status of the key performance indicators for FY 2024-2025 to this Ministry (Attn: Mrs N. Aubdoollah-Suhootoorah nsuhootoorah@govmu.org) for the Progress Report on Performance in respect of Outcomes Achieved and Outputs Delivered that will be included in the Financial Statements of Government, which will be audited by the National Audit Office.

Annual Report on Performance

- 11. Ministries and Departments are now required to table before the National Assembly their Annual Report on Performance (Financial and Non-Financial) for the previous financial year as well as on their strategic direction in respect of the following 3 financial years. A copy of the Annual Report should be submitted to this Ministry by 31st October of each year.
- 12. In this regard, you are requested to include information on the following in your Annual Report: (i) About the Ministry/Department; (ii) Achievements and Challenges; (iii) Financial Performance; and (iv) Way Forward. You should also include information on the progress of the implementation of measures in the Government Programme and the Budget Speech, a Gender Policy Statement, as well as actions taken to address issues identified in the Director of Audit Report.
- 13. In the past years, a number of Ministries and Departments did not submit their Annual Report on Performance within the statutory deadline, that is, by 31st October. You are, therefore, requested to ensure the timely submission of the 2024-2025 Annual Report.

14. Furthermore, this Ministry will publish a dashboard on the financial and non-financial performance of Ministries and Departments for the previous financial year. In this regard, you are requested to provide the relevant information for FY 2024-2025 to this Ministry (Attn: Mrs N. Aubdoollah-Suhootoorah) by 31st October 2025. The template for the information requested will be sent to you shortly.

Strengthening Budget Governance and Fiscal Discipline

- 15. In view of the high level of budget deficit and public sector debt, strengthening budget governance and fiscal discipline is critical. It is key to restoring financial stability, ensuring greater transparency and accountability, and making sure public funds deliver real impact for the economy and society. In this regard, you must ensure that:
 - (a) an appropriate mechanism is put in place for effective monitoring and recovery of revenue arrears, and to minimise occurrence of such arrears;
 - (b) the approval of this Ministry on all matters relating to taxes, levies, charges and fees, including tax exemptions, is obtained before signing any Memorandum of Understanding, contract or agreement. Provisions relating to taxes in new legislations will also need the approval of this Ministry;
 - (c) expenditure remains strictly within the limits approved by the National Assembly;
 - (d) any requirements for additional funds are, as far as possible, met through reallocation of funds within the same Programme, in accordance with Financial Instructions No. 2 of 2025;
 - (e) expenditures are incurred only where there is an approved budgetary provision and confirmed availability of funds, in full compliance with established financial regulations and procedures;
 - (f) prior financial clearance of this Ministry is sought for any proposal that entails an additional commitment of public funds or may result in the creation of a liability;
 - (g) all expenditures are accurately charged to the correct Item of Expenditure and Programme as approved in the Budget Estimates;
 - (h) internal control systems are strengthened to prevent unauthorised, irregular, or wasteful expenditure; and
 - (i) a close oversight of public bodies falling under your purview is exercised so that these entities meet their financial obligations, prepare and implement a turnaround plan in case of financial difficulties, and table before the National Assembly their Annual Report and Financial Statements in line with statutory requirements. A copy of the turnaround plan should be submitted to this Ministry (Attn: Mr S. Doorgapersand sdoorgapersand@govmu.org).
- 16. You are also encouraged to leverage digital technologies and AI tools to improve processes, reduce administrative costs, achieve greater efficiency gains, and enhance service delivery. For this purpose, in consultation with the Ministry of Technology, Communication and Innovation, you may wish to apply for funding under Item 22900046: Public Sector AI Programme under Programme 2702: Centrally Managed Initiatives of Government.

17. Furthermore, you may request funding from the allocation under Item 22900045: Expenses icw Research and Innovation, within Programme 2702: Centrally Managed Initiatives of Government, to support research initiatives aimed at fostering innovation in policy formulation and implementation, promoting evidence-based decision-making, and encouraging a culture of continuous improvement across Government, as outlined in the Budget Speech.

Implementation of Infrastructure Projects

- 18. Modernising the physical landscape is critical not only to improving public service delivery, but also to driving economic growth, attracting investment, and enhancing international competitiveness. In this regard and also to prevent delays and cost overruns, you must take appropriate actions to ensure that all approved projects are:
 - (a) properly planned and costed prior to implementation;
 - (b) underpinned by realistic implementation schedules and cash flow projections; and
 - (c) executed in compliance with procurement and other applicable legislations and procedures.
- 19. With regard to the monitoring of the status of implementation of key infrastructure projects, you must:
 - (a) upload the implementation milestones and timelines for each project on the e-PMIS system; and
 - (b) provide an update on the e-PMIS system on a monthly basis, i.e., within 10 days following the end of each reference month, on the status of implementation, including any delays and/or bottlenecks, and the actions taken to address them.
- 20. You are encouraged to seek, if required, technical support from the Project Management and Contract Administration Unit, set up at the level of this Ministry (Attn: Mr K. Santchurn pmcaunit@govmu.org), for any advice on project planning, contract management, dispute resolution, and quality assurance.

Revised Estimates

- 21. Ministries and Departments are required to prepare quarterly revised budget estimates, reflecting both actual expenditures to date and projected spending through the end of the financial year.
- 22. Based on the revised budget estimates, you must report any significant deviations in revenue, recurrent expenditure, or capital expenditure to this Ministry, along with appropriate justifications, within 10 days after the end of each quarter.

Electronic Project Monitoring Information System

- 23. As stated above, monitoring and reporting on the status of implementation of (i) the budget measures, (ii) the key performance indicators in the PBB, and (iii) infrastructure projects will be done on the e-PMIS. In this regard, you should assign dedicated staff for updating the e-PMIS on a regular basis and within the set deadlines.
- 24. Delays in providing updated information will hinder the proper monitoring of implementation progress and also prevent this Ministry from reporting effectively to the High-Level Steering Committee on the Government Programme set up at the Prime Minister's Office, which is also responsible for overseeing the implementation of budget measures. Timely submission of updates is, therefore, critical.
- 25. Furthermore, you should ensure that the information submitted is relevant, accurate and complete.

- 26. The list of SMSTs and Officers of the Financial Operations Cadre who would be interfacing with your respective Ministry and Department as well as their contact details are provided at **Annex I**.
- 27. Kindly convey the contents of this Circular Letter to all Departments and public bodies falling under your responsibility. I trust that you will extend your full cooperation and attention to the matters outlined above.
