Mrs Deviantee Sobarun brings extensive expertise in land and revenue law to the Revenue Tribunal, having served the Registrar-General's Department for 45 years. Out of these 45 years, she served as the Registrar-General for 12 years until her retirement and cumulated the roles of Conservator of Mortgages as well as "Authorised Officer" for Campement and Campement Site Tax.

During her tenure as Registrar General, Mrs Sobarun drove several key reform projects, most notably the Mauritius eRegistry Project (MeRP), which transformed the Registrar-General's Department from a paper-based system to a comprehensive e-Service. She also led the Deed Component of the Land Administration Valuation and Information System (LAVIMS). These reforms significantly improved Mauritius's international ranking in the Ease of Doing Business for property registration. Following her retirement, she served as a Consultant for the Ease of Doing Business Team at the Economic Development Board, where she played an active role in implementing the World Bank's Collateral Register project. She also lectures on Revenue Laws for law practitioners (Notary stream) at the University of Mauritius under the aegis of the Council of Vocational and Legal Education.
