Execution of the 2026-2027 Performance-Based Budget

The purpose of this Circular Letter is to set out the guidelines and instructions for the effective execution and monitoring of the 2026-2027 Performance-Based Budget (PBB) by Ministries, Departments and other Public Bodies.

2. The achievement of the objectives articulated in the 2026-2027 Budget Speech will depend critically on the effective and timely implementation of the measures announced. In this context, Ministries, Departments and other Public Bodies have a central responsibility in ensuring that these measures are implemented as intended and that approved programmes and projects deliver the expected results. This requires effective planning and execution, continuous monitoring of progress and outcomes, and the prudent and efficient use of public resources.

3. Supervising Officers are therefore requested to put in place appropriate internal mechanisms to ensure the effective implementation of the guidelines and instructions contained in this Circular.

Implementation of Budget Measures

4. Ministries and Departments should ensure the effective and timely implementation of all Budget Measures under their responsibility. To this end, Ministries and Departments should:

- (a) work out implementation plans for each Budget Measure, with clear milestones, deliverables and implementation timelines; and
- (b) identify implementation risks and bottlenecks, and take appropriate measures.

5. For monitoring purposes, this Ministry has already provided each Ministry and Department with a tailor-made soft copy file containing the Budget Measures falling under its responsibility. You are required to submit a monthly progress report as per the file to the relevant Sector Ministry Support Team (SMST) of this Ministry within 10 days following the end of the reference month.

6. Measures announced in the 2025-2026 Budget Speech and its Annex will continue to be monitored until they are fully operational. You are, therefore, requested to also submit a monthly progress report on these measures.

Performance-Based Budget

7. The PBB framework has been introduced to strengthen the link between Government policies, resource allocation, service delivery, and measurable outputs and outcomes.
8. Ministries and Departments should, therefore, closely monitor the implementation of their strategies as well as progress towards achieving the approved outputs and outcomes, and the relevant Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) in the 2026–2027 PBB Estimates. They may also establish additional operational KPIs to strengthen performance monitoring.
9. Ministries and Departments should submit quarterly updates on the KPIs to the relevant SMST of this Ministry within 10 days following the end of each quarter, indicating progress against targets, and any significant shortfalls and corresponding corrective measures.
10. They should also submit, by **30 September 2026**, to this Ministry (Attn: Mrs N. Aubdoollah-Suhootoorah – nsuhootoorah@govmu.org) information on the status of the KPIs for FY 2025-2026 for inclusion in the Financial Statements of Government, which will be audited by the National Audit Office.

Annual Report on Performance

11. In accordance with the Finance and Audit Act, Ministries and Departments should table their Annual Reports on Performance for FY 2025-2026 before the National Assembly by **31 October 2026**. A copy of the Report should also be submitted to the relevant SMST of this Ministry.
12. The Annual Report should, *inter alia*, cover an overview of the Ministry/Department and its strategic priorities; key achievements and outcomes; financial performance; progress in implementing Budget Measures; performance against KPIs; corrective actions taken in response to findings of the Director of Audit; Gender Policy Statement; Green Budgeting achievements, where applicable; and priorities for the next three financial years.

Strengthening Budget Governance and Fiscal Discipline

13. Fiscal sustainability is a collective responsibility, requiring every Ministry and Department to exercise prudence, strengthen expenditure discipline and ensure value for money in the use of public resources.
14. In this regard, Ministries and Departments should ensure that:
 - (a) expenditure remains strictly within the limits approved by the National Assembly;
 - (b) any requirements for additional funds are, as far as possible, met through reallocation of funds within the same Programme, in accordance with the Virement Rule in the Financial Instructions No. 2 of 2025;

- (c) expenditures are incurred only where there is an approved budgetary provision and confirmed availability of funds, in full compliance with established financial regulations and procedures;
- (d) certified and approved claims are settled on time, in line with the applicable financial procedures, and any risk of expenditure arrears is reported to this Ministry at the earliest possible, together with appropriate corrective measures;
- (e) prior financial clearance of this Ministry is sought for any proposal that entails an additional commitment of public funds or may result in the creation of a liability;
- (f) all expenditures are charged under the appropriate Item of Expenditure and Programme as approved in the Budget Estimates; and
- (g) internal control systems are strengthened to prevent unauthorised, irregular, or wasteful expenditure.

15. Ministries and Departments are also requested to:

- (a) put in place an appropriate mechanism for effective monitoring and recovery of revenue arrears; and
- (b) seek approval of this Ministry on all matters relating to taxes, levies, charges and fees, including tax exemptions, before signing any Memorandum of Understanding, contract or agreement.

Implementation and Monitoring of Infrastructure Projects

16. Government investment in infrastructure development is critical to supporting economic growth and improving public service delivery. In this regard, Ministries and Departments are required to ensure the timely implementation of projects within their approved project value.

17. Ministries and Departments should therefore:

- (a) ensure that projects are executed in compliance with procurement and other applicable legislations and procedures;
- (b) closely monitor the physical and financial progress of infrastructure projects;
- (c) take timely corrective measures to address any implementation issues; and
- (d) report to this Ministry any significant deviation in project scope, implementation schedule or cost against initial plans and expenditure forecasts.

18. Monthly updates on implementation of key infrastructure projects should be submitted to the relevant SMST within 10 days following the end of each reference month.

19. For any advice on project planning, contract management, dispute resolution and quality assurance, Supervising Officers may contact the Project Management and Contract Administration Unit set up at the level of this Ministry at pmcaunit@govmu.org.

Management and Oversight of Public Bodies

20. Ministries should exercise effective oversight over Public Bodies falling under their purview so as to ensure that they operate in line with Government policies, statutory requirements and the principles of sound public financial management.

21. Supervising Officers should therefore:

- (a) ensure that Public Bodies submit their Audited Financial Statements and Annual Reports within the statutory deadlines and that these are laid before the National Assembly in accordance with the relevant legislation;
- (b) engage proactively with the Boards and Management of Public Bodies, facing financial or operational challenges, to implement corrective measures, including turnaround or restructuring plans; and
- (c) monitor the financial exposure of Government arising from guarantees, loans, equity participation and other contingent liabilities relating to Public Bodies.

22. Ministries are required to report to this Ministry any significant financial risks and/or corrective measures being implemented by Public Bodies.

Audit and Public Sector Efficiency

23. Government is fully committed to promoting efficiency, effectiveness and value for money in the management and use of public resources. In this regard, Ministries and Departments are required to:

- (a) take appropriate corrective actions to address the issues and weaknesses highlighted in the Director of Audit Reports; and
- (b) implement concrete plans to improve efficiency, eliminate unnecessary duplication and reduce wastage, without compromising service delivery.

24. Ministries and Departments are encouraged to leverage digital technologies and Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools to improve processes, achieve efficiency gains and enhance service delivery. In this context, funds have been provided in the budget for the implementation of a Public Sector AI Programme and a Research and Innovation Programme under *Centrally Managed Initiatives of Government*. The modalities for application and disbursement for the two programmes will be communicated in due course.

Monthly Revenue and Expenditure Forecasts

25. At the beginning of FY 2026-2027, Ministries and Departments were required to input their monthly revenue and expenditure forecasts in the Treasury Accounting System. Those that have not yet entered their forecasts in the System are requested to do so at the earliest.

26. Ministries and Departments should ensure that:
- (a) the forecasts are worked out at item level;
 - (b) the sum of the monthly forecasts is equal to the amount voted under the PBB Estimates;
 - (c) the monthly forecasts are credible; and
 - (d) the forecasts are not modified during budget execution as they will be used for the purpose of monitoring of revenue and expenditure performance.

Revised Estimates

27. Ministries and Departments should prepare Revised Estimates for the financial year on a quarterly basis taking into account actual performance to date, developments during budget execution, updated implementation plans for projects and schemes, revenue and expenditure commitments taken during the course of the year, and the latest forecasts of revenue and expenditure. The Revised Estimates should be realistic and reflect the expected outturn for the financial year.

28. A soft copy of the Revised Estimates should be submitted to the relevant SMST of this Ministry within 10 days following the end of each quarter. The submission should include explanations for any significant deviations from the approved Budget Estimates and indicate the corrective measures being taken, where applicable.
