VOTE 1-13 INDEPENDENT BROADCASTING AUTHORITY

CONTEXT FOR BUDGET INTERVENTION

The Independent Broadcasting Authority i) promotes the provision of a diverse range of radio and television broadcasting in Mauritius; ii) promotes the development of broadcasting services which are responsive to the needs of the Mauritian audience; iii) preserves and promotes the plural nature of Mauritian culture by ensuring that licensees include in their services programmes reflecting the linguistic and cultural diversity of Mauritius; iv) ensures that licensees include in their services regular locally produced programmes; v) ensures that broadcasting services are not controlled by foreign nationals; vi) imposes limitations on cross media control of private broadcasting services; vii) ensures fair competition between broadcasting licensees; viii) sets acceptable standards for programmes and advertising and monitor compliance with those standards; ix) ensures that broadcasting services are of such a nature as not to encourage or incite crime or racial hatred leading to disorder or offending public feeling; give adequate coverage to information, education, culture, entertainment and recreation; and are impartial and accurate; x) be the sole authority empowered to issue licenses for broadcasting; xi) levies fees in respect of licenses issued; xii) inquires into public complaints against a licensee and takes any action it thinks appropriate; xiii) promotes together with the Mauritius Telecommunications Authority, the most efficient use of the broadcasting frequency bands; and xiv) monitors, after consultation with the Mauritius Telecommunications Authority, the availability of segments of broadcasting frequency bands and make recommendations for the allocations of frequencies to licensees of broadcasting services.
