MISSION

Ensure that licensees deliver quality programs and services that educate, inform, enlighten and entertain viewers and listeners.

STRATEGY

The Independent Broadcasting Authority (IBA) was set up by an Act of Parliament in August 2000 and was constituted in April 2001.

The IBA is the sole authority to grant licences for the provision of a broadcasting service and the prescription of fees payable for such licences. The IBA regulates the broadcasting services so as to:

- (i) Promote diversity, wider choice in the field of broadcasting through the setting of standards for the delivery of high quality service;
- (ii) Ensure that broadcasters operate in a level playing field where fair competition is the rule;
- (ii) Ensure that broadcasters preserve and promote the plural nature of the Mauritian society by specially dedicated content; and
- (iv) Provide protection and avenues for redress and representation to listeners and viewers in their relationship with operators.
