#### Housing

- Delays in allocating contracts for social housing projects due to non-responsiveness to tender requirements.
  - Procurement methods such as launching tenders on a Bill of Quantities (BOQ) procurement method will be envisaged.
  - The Ministry will implement a housing project on a pilot basis.
- Rental Market in the housing sector is partly inactive.
  - Review of the Landlord and Tenant Act to facilitate access to privately rented houses to middle income group.

#### Land Use Planning

- Need for an updated and regularly reviewed sustainable planning framework to ensure development occurs in a planned and orderly manner:-
  - More regular review of spatial development plans at national, local and area-wise levels/scales.
  - Inadequate and insufficient expertise in human resources addressed through merging of Town and Country Planning Board (TCPB) and recruitment of additional Planners.
  - Conducting training sessions for Planners at central and local government and awareness sessions for Board of Investment (BOI) and other stakeholders on a regular basis.

#### Land Management

- Delay in the process of land acquisition for major development projects.
  - Setting up of committees, led by Ministry of Housing and Lands, in line Ministries where major infrastructure projects are being undertaken to follow up the process of land acquisition.
- Delay in the processing of application for leases.
  - Processes for grant of lease enhanced through a computerized State land register and lease administration system.
- Delay in the payment of compensation for land acquisition.
  - Appropriate legislation introduced for prompt payment on land acquisition.
