# Notes on the Department

#### **Mission Statement**

To provide accurate and timely weather information and meteorological services for the protection of life and property and general welfare of citizens.

### **Strategic Direction**

- Advance scientific research and implement new technologies to generate better and more precise weather, climate and water information and warnings.
- Enhance capabilities to access, develop, implement and use integrated and interoperable earth and space based observation system to align up to the standard set up by the World Meteorological Organisation.
- Support socio-economic and environmental development by providing useful information to policy makers and economic operators.

### Key Actions for 2015/2016

- Enhance climate related forecasts and warnings in response to users' needs by improving accuracy of weather forecasts to at least 88% (actual 2014 : 87%).
- Timely provision of weather, water and climate information for the citizens and other user communities in all cases (actual 2014: 95%).

### Human Resource Allocation

The Department has 151 funded positions for 2015/2016.
