- Reinforce special witness schemes.
- Promote continuous professional development for all Court Personnel at the Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies.


## Main Achievements for FY 2015/16

- Pilot Phase E-Judiciary System completed.
- Number of outstanding cases at the Mediation Division of the Supreme Court has considerably been reduced from 82 in 2014 to 39 in 2015.
- Training/Capacity building conducted:
(i) Training on Case Management at Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies for Court Managers.
(ii) Commonwealth Secretariat training courses in December 2015 on Judicial Independence, Ethics and Judgment Writing for Judges and Magistrates.
(ii) Sponsoring of Diploma in Legal Studies and Court Administration - 14 Officers of the Court Cadre are following the Diploma Course (August 2015- December 2016).
