#### **Mission Statement**

To maintain an impartial and efficient justice system that upholds the rule of law and provides modern, easy and fast access to justice to all.

#### **Strategic Direction 2016-2019**

- Introduce legislation to set up a separate Court of Appeal and a separate High Court Section of the Supreme Court to improve public perception of independence and objectivity in dispensing justice and to streamline appeal cases.
- A state-of-the art Court Building for the Supreme Court and all its divisions.
- Focus on the maintenance and upgrading of all District Court premises to ensure better services to all stakeholders.
- Reinforce special witness schemes.
- Promote continuous professional development for all Court Personnel at the Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies.

### Main Achievements for FY 2015/16

- Pilot Phase E-Judiciary System completed.
- Number of outstanding cases at the Mediation Division of the Supreme Court has considerably been reduced from 82 in 2014 to 39 in 2015.
- Training/Capacity building conducted:
  - (i) Training on Case Management at Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies for Court Managers.
  - (ii) Commonwealth Secretariat training courses in December 2015 on Judicial Independence, Ethics and Judgment Writing for Judges and Magistrates.
  - (ii) Sponsoring of Diploma in Legal Studies and Court Administration 14 Officers of the Court Cadre are following the Diploma Course (August 2015- December 2016).
