Vote on Account for the period of Six Months Ending 31st December 2016 -

Financial Clearance for Overseas Mission and Training

The Accountant-General has, in a letter dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 2016, informed Supervising Officers of the arrangements which have been put in place under Vote on Account to incur public expenditure from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016 until the coming into operation of the Appropriation Act 2016-2017.

- 2. With regard to expenditure for official Missions and Training/Workshops/ Seminars abroad, an amount of Rs120 million was voted in Estimates 2015-2016 under the Centralised Vote. In line with the Circular issued by the Accountant-General, the maximum provision for the above purpose under Vote on Account is Rs60 million for period 1st July to 31st December 2016.
- 3. As from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 and **until further notice**, Supervising Officers are required to seek financial clearance from this Ministry in respect of any Official proceeding on each Mission or Training/Workshop/Seminar abroad before seeking Prime Minister's approval.
- 4. Once financial clearance is obtained, a Departmental Warrant will be issued to meet expenses in relation to mission and training/workshop/seminar abroad.
- 5. You are kindly requested to bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of the Accounting Officers and other relevant officers concerned in your Ministry/Department.
