### **Programme 141: Protection and Promotion of Human Rights**

**Priority Objectives:** 

- Ensure that the number of complaints in connection with violation of human rights decreases over time.
- Ensure that the number of complaints of sex discrimination and sexual harassment decreases over time.

Major Services:

 Holding of structured meetings with relevant stakeholders (police, prisons, trade unions, women associations, students, NGOs, employers etc.) to ensure efficient and timely processing of complaints and awareness of appropriate legislations.
