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PART A: OVERVIEW OF MINISTRY

I. STRATEGIC NOTE

1. Major Achievements for 2011

- Five new Speaking Unions (Arabic, Bhojpuri, Chinese, Creole and Sanskrit) set up by way of legislation to promote ancestral languages.
- Three new *Centre de Lecture Publique et d'Animation Culturelle* operational in Flic en Flac, Caroline and Pailles to encourage and promote reading, artistic, cultural and educational activities.
- New *Centre de Formation Artistique* set up in Goodlands to provide training in various art forms.
- Festival Mauricien event organised in March throughout the country in the context of the 2011 National Day Celebrations, providing a common platform for local established and emerging artists, and international artists.
- Mauritius won the Gold Award (in the Inter-School Category) at the International SLAM Competition held in France in May 2011.
- Two additional sculptures completed by artists from India and the People's Republic of China at the International Slave Route Monument at Le Morne.
- 300 artists assisted under financial schemes as at September 2011.
- 100 artists benefitted from the International Development Grant Scheme as at September 2011, enabling artists to obtain international exposure and upgrade their skills.
- 30,000 out of 150,000 records restored by the National Archives as at October 2011.
- 35,388 cinema films classified by the Film Classification Board as at October 2011.

2. Major constraints and challenges and how they are being addressed

- Speaking Unions and Cultural Centres have high administrative costs and limited resources for activities.
 - Speaking Unions and Cultural Centres will be called upon to collaborate and use common facilities in terms of infrastructure and secretariat.
- Limited revenue generating capacity of local museums due to low interest among Mauritians and underdevelopment of the tourism market in this field.
 - A Master Plan is being prepared to consider measures to uplift existing infrastructure, and raise revenue, through the operation of souvenir shops and organisation of artistic activities at the museums.
- Lack of appropriate infrastructure to meet the needs of artists for rehearsals, and mounting of shows and events.
 - Arrangements are being made with the Ministry of Education & HR and the Ministry of Youth & Sports to use their infrastructure.

3. Strategic Direction 2012-2014

The Ministry aims at providing for the artistic and cultural needs of the country and contribute to skills development, job creation, economic growth and social cohesion by:

- developing and promoting arts and culture, and mainstream its role in social development;
- preserving and promoting cultural diversity and inter-cultural dialogue;
- preserving tangible, intangible and documentary heritage;
- preserving and promoting written and spoken languages;
- improving economic, legal and infrastructural set up in the arts and culture sector;
- consolidating ties with friendly countries and further enhancing links with regional and international organisations;
- ensuring capacity building in the field of arts and culture; and
- safeguarding the interest of artists and promoting the creative industry.
