

STRATEGIC OVERVIEW

I. Mission Statement

- To provide a framework conducive for the growth of the construction industry and for ensuring that all Government buildings and roads are constructed in line with eco-friendly international norms, standards and practices
- To enhance the quality of life of citizens through essential community infrastructure, and to protect them against flood by providing effective drainage system

II. Current Situation & Challenges

- As at 2019, the total road network stood at 2,772 km, of which 1,249 km were classified roads (including 104 km of Motorway).
- During FY 2020/21, 105 km of existing roads have been upgraded and/or resurfaced and 5 km of new roads added to the classified roads.
- As at March 2021, there were 1,514 contractors and 252 consultants registered with the Construction Industry Development Board operating in the construction industry.
- The National Development Unit (NDU) operates 36 Citizens Advice Bureaus (CAB) across the island, including one in Rodrigues, where the public can avail facilities for online services and address their community concerns. During FY 2020/21, the following projects were completed:
 - 85 secondary roads;
 - 25 drain projects; and
 - 20 amenities.

Key Challenges

- Traffic congestion leading to longer travel time and higher vehicle operating costs
- Inadequate plan for maintaining Government buildings and vehicles is impairing effectiveness of public services leading to higher operating and replacement costs
- Mitigating the effect of flash floods adversely affecting our infrastructure and living environment
