#### I. Mission Statement

- To empower young people and instil a culture of individual excellence and encourage solidarity among Mauritians
- To promote excellence in sports for Mauritian athletes to shine internationally
- To foster a culture of community sport, physical and recreational activities for a healthy nation

### II. Current Situation & Challenges

#### **Youth Empowerment and Recreation**

- 24 equipped Youth Centres carry out diverse activities for the empowerment of the youth.
- Around 14,000 youths participated in National Youth Civic Service, Smart Youth and Volunteer Mauritius Programmes from July 2021 to May 2022.
- More than 2,500 participants were involved in several recreational activities such as "Zenes Montre To Talan" and "Street Dance Battle" in FY 2021-2022.
- National Youth Council has organised 19 events with the participation of 15,141 youths and is also working on the revamping of 8 Youth Centres to transform them into modern Youth Hubs in FY 2021-2022.

#### **Sports**

- As at April 2022, 113 athletes are benefitting from the High-Level Athletes Allowance Scheme.

- The 22<sup>nd</sup> Senior African Athletics Championship will be held in Mauritius from 8 to 12 June 2022 with the participation of 622 athletes from 54 countries.
- The 12<sup>th</sup> Commission de la Jeunesse et des Sports de l'Océan Indien (CJSOI) Games will be held in Mauritius from 4 to 11 December 2022, with the participation of around 800 athletes from 7 countries.
- 27 Sports facilities and 4 Outdoor Centres are managed by the Mauritius Sports Council.
- From July 2021 to March 2022, there were around 146,000 participants in the programmes held under Active Mauritius (LAMPS<sup>1</sup>, Youth on the Move, Elderly Fitness and Sports Medicine).

#### **Key Challenges**

- Enhancing the level of participation and interest among the population for sports and physical activities
- Putting in place a specialised unit for the maintenance of major sports facilities
- Optimising the use of existing sports facilities falling under different Ministries/Agencies
- Need to reinforce capacity building and networking among youth NGOs and other relevant stakeholders
